DÉFINITIONS

In the College academic calendar, the terms listed below are officially defined as follows:

Class Day:

A day on which the teacher must actually meet with their student groups, as scheduled.

Pedagogical Day:

A day of educational activities related to teaching and learning, excluding the delivery of instruction to students and their evaluation.

Holiday:

A statutory holiday as defined in the teachers' collective agreement.

Evaluation Day (Exam period):

A day that allows for the organization of exams or the holding of learning assessment activities.

Orientation and Registration Day:

A day dedicated to welcoming students, registration, and course selection changes.

Reading week:

A period during which there are no classes for students.
